

## Registration Requirements

A child entering our Preschool 4 program must be 4 years old by August 1<sup>st</sup> of the year they are enrolled.

Registration will be open beginning on February 3, 2020. A Registration Night will be held on Tuesday, February 11, 2020, 6:00 – 7:30 p.m. All new families to Zion Lutheran School should attend this session.

While our Preschool 4 program is for classroom environment and learning, a child entering this program must be toilet trained, out of pull ups, and away from “sippie cup” use by their first day of class.

If there are any special needs to be considered when class assignments are made, parents need to have a one-on-one discussion with the ZLS Principal by no later than May 22, 2020. While consideration will be given to these requests, please remember that there are no automatic guarantees.

### Preschool Days and Times

Preschool 4 classes meet three half days a week. Those days are to be determined but are typically Monday, Wednesday & Friday.

**Morning classes are held from 8:00 – 11:00 a.m.**

**Afternoon classes are held from 12:00 – 3:00 p.m.**

## Registration & Tuition Fees

### Tuition Fees

#### Preschool 4 Registration Fees

\$200/\$180 if paid by April 1, 2020.

This is due at the time of registration and is in addition to tuition.

IT IS NON-REFUNDABLE.

#### Tuition

Tuition Fees are annual amounts; however, for the convenience of our school families, payments can be made over eight months (September - April) of the school year.

Tuition is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month.

Monthly payment amount: \$195.00

On My Way Pre-K Tuition: “State” assistance if a family meets financial requirements.

**Families will be required to pay the cost difference.**
