# Available!



Thanks to a couple of recent large donations from Zion school supporters, Zion is offering generous scholarships for Kindergarten for the 2021-2022 year that, for many, will significantly reduce both registration and tuition costs.

These scholarships are available through the Lutheran Scholarship Granting Organization of Indiana (the Lutheran SGO).

To qualify, applicants must meet income eligibility guidelines, typically based on Adjusted Gross Income as listed on your previous year Form 1040 tax returns.

As you can see from the accompanying chart, the guidelines are based on household size and are generous in terms of the household income that qualifies.

Currently, in our Lutheran school system in Seymour, a significant percentage of our school families in K-12 receive funds from one of these scholarships or from the state school choice voucher program. Receiving an SGO scholarship in kindergarten makes possible a school choice voucher in successive years. In other words, an SGO scholarship in Zion's Kindergarten qualifies the student to receive voucher funds in first grade at Immanuel.

Together, these two programs make possible a quality Christian education for children whose families would not otherwise be able to afford it.
