\$0.50 classroom/extra milk

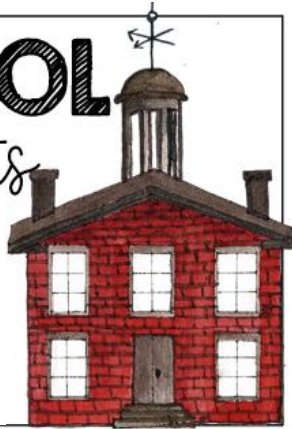
